Profile of the College

Lumding College is situated in the heart of Lumding town in the district of Hojai in the state of Assam. It is one of the oldest colleges in this remote part of the country. The college was established on 14th August, 1959 by a group of visionary academicians, patriots and philanthropists who aspired for the growth of higher education in the small town of Lumding. Since its inception, the college had struggled through difficult phases of hardship to achieve its present status. The college was taken under the deficit system of grant-in-aid by the Govt. of Assam on 1st December, 1972. It was provincialised by the Govt. of Assam on 1st December, 2005.

Today, Lumding College offers Higher Secondary as well as Three Year Degree (TDC) courses in three streams: Arts, Science and Commerce. It is affiliated to Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC) and Gauhati University (GU) respectively. Apart from these, it also offers some professional and self-financing courses. Today, it has an enrollment of more than 2000 students from diverse backgrounds who create a vibrant atmosphere in the college campus. The students have been producing remarkable results in academics as well as cocurricular activities with the guidance and encouragement of very dedicated faculty members. The college has also produced students who have managed to achieve top positions in the final examinations.

Lumding College was accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with B+ grade in 2004 and in cycle-II, the College was re-accredited by the NAAC with B grade in 2018. It is upgraded to Model Degree College by RUSA in 2019. It gives utmost importance to enhance the quality of higher education by considering the needs and expectations of each and every student. It has spacious Classrooms, well-equipped science Laboratories, a Language Lab, a rich Library with internet facilities, separate Departmental Library, free Wi-Fi facility, an AC Seminar Hall, a Central computer room, a Northeast Heritage Centre, a two-storey Girls' hostel, well-furnished separate Common rooms for Boys and Girls and a Canteen with hygienic food. Adequate facilities for games and sports, amenity for safe drinking water and a vehicle shed. It is in the process of constructing smart classrooms for advanced teaching- learning process.

The fraternity of Lumding College also considers the aspirations of people who could not pursue higher education due to various reasons. It has opened a study centre of the K.K. Handique State Open University which offers degree programmes such as BA, B.Sc., B.Com., BBA and BCA in the Distance mode. It has also opened a contact centre of the Institute of Distance and Open Learning (IDOL), Gauhati University in the campus which helps in pursuing various post-graduate programmes in the Distance mode.

NOTE:

- i) Statistics is not allowed without Mathematics.
- ii) Statistics-Geology combination is not allowed.
- iii) It is desirable that students intending to offer Physics/Chemistry as elective subjects offer Mathematics also as one of the elective subjects.
- iv) Additional Subject will not be allowed to those who have secured less than 40% marks on aggregate in HSLC or equivalent exam.
- v) A student can offer maximum four elective subjects as his / her combination, but the subject in which he / she secures lowest marks in the Final Examination would be treated as his / her 4th subject and no marks of it would be credited to better his / her results.
- vi) It is advisable that all those who intend to pursue the H.S. Course in commerce offer Economics as one of their optional subjects in their own future interest.
- vii) Students of HS-1st year will have to study Environmental Education as a compulsory subject.

Four years undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) Under NEP 2020

Gauhati University under the new education policy (NEP) 2020 is going to introduce the Four years undergraduate programme (FYUGP) for the session 2023-24. The Course structure of FYUGP is built on the Choice-based Credit System (CBCS). The FYUGP under NEP has the following features.

1. It is a 4 years degree programme instead of 3 years under CBCS.
2. The FYUGP provides multiple exits and entries. One has the choice to exit from the programme thrice – after one year, after two years and after three years. If one exits after one year, gets a Certificate. If one exits after two years, gets a Diploma. If one exits after three year gets Bachelor's degree. And finally, if a student completes the whole 4 year, one gets a Bachelor's degree (Honours).
3. There are two parts of Courses under the FYUGP- (a) Core Courses and (b) Common Courses. Different students study different Core Courses and all students study the Common Courses. The details are shown below.

Degree First year (Arts & Science)

Here the College only uploading Degree 1st years syllabi (1st Semester and 2nd Semester). As the Course progresses, the remaining part of the syllabi will be uploaded subsequently.

First year (Semester I & II)

In the 1st year one studies three different Core subjects – one paper of each subject per semester and one needs to study four Common subjects which the University has designed. Details of the subjects are described in the booklet. There is no differences between major and non-major students till Semester III. One can opt major from 4th semester onwards of the course structure for later semester will be informed later.

The following figure shows the Core and Common subject for 1st year Semester I & II under (FYUGP)



List of Core subjects offered by the College in Humanities- Assamese, English, Bengali, Hindi, Economics, Education, History, Political Science.

A student in 1st year (1st & 2nd semester) may choose any three Core subject, one paper from each subject from the list of subjects provided above.

Common courses

The common courses are to be studied by all students alike and all-together they carry a total credits of 36 over a 3-year period. These courses are further divided into five (5) subcategories, as described below.

1. Multi-disciplinary Courses

These are 3-credit courses spanning over five different groups of subjects—(i) Natural and Physical Science, (ii) Mathematics, Statistics, and Computer Applications, (iii) Library, Information, and Media Sciences, (iv) Commerce and Management, and (v) Humanities and Social Sciences. The level of these courses are of Class XII. Each student need to take at any three papers, each with 3-credits from these five sub-groups during Semesters 1-3. However, Lumding College will offer only two different groups of subject -1. Natural and Physical Science, and 2. Mathematics, Statistics, and Computer Applications, for B.Sc. and only one group ie. Humanities and Social Sciences for B.A.

2. Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC)

This is an 8-credit course covering Modern Indian Languages (MIL) and English Usage (Communication). Each student needs to complete two papers of 4-credits each – one from English Usage and other from the group of MIL, especially designed for this purpose. Both these courses are further divided into two 2-credit courses each. The English Communication course is to be completed during Semesters 1-2 and the MIL course is to be completed during Semesters 5-6.

3. Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) These are various skill courses with total credit allocation of 9. All students need to complete three skill courses, each with 3 credits during Semesters 1-3.

4. Value Added Courses (VAC)

The VAC courses will come from four sub groups—(i) Understanding India, (ii) Environmental Science, (iii) Digital and Technological Solutions, and (iv) Health & Wellness, Yoga Education, Sports, and Fitness. All together they will have a credit allocation of 6. Each student will have to take any three courses, each of 2-credit, from any three groups during Semesters 1, 2, & 4. Here one course from the Environmental Science group is compulsory except if the student takes a core course on Environmental Science.

INTAKE CAPACITY:

All admissions to Higher Secondary First Year and TDC First Semester in Lumding College shall be in accordance to Uniform Policy of Admission of Students into the Colleges in different Streams of Government and Provincialised Colleges of Assam vide Govt. of Assam O.M. No.AHE.250/2014/1, dated 05-06-2014.

As per Govt. of Assam rules, there is a provision for reservation of seats for SC, ST(P), ST(H), OBC/MOBC, Differently abled candidates belonging to the State of Assam seeking admission into colleges in different streams of Government and Provincialised Colleges of Assam. Moreover, Govt. of Assam has earmarked a maximum of 5% seats for outstanding Sports Persons, Wards of the employees of the colleges, NCC Cadets/Scouts & Guides, Persons with Proficiency in Cultural Activities. In compliance with the above rules/instructions/guidelines, the number of seats to be offered for admission for the academic session 2022-23 in different class/stream under each programme of study are hereby notified for general information.

Further, it is notified to all concerned that admission shall be on the basis of merit based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination, subject to above reservation of seats, and that there shall be no discretionary Quota of Seats to be filled up by the Principal, Donor or any other authority.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

(A) Eligibility for Admission - Higher Secondary:

Candidates who have passed the HSLC Exam. of the Board of Secondary Education, Assam or any other equivalent Exam. recognised by the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC) are eligible for admission to Higher Secondary First Year course provided that:

- (i) A candidate seeking admission to HS Science must have secured at least 45% marks on aggregate in the HSLC or its equivalent Exam.
- (ii) Candidates belonging to SC, ST, OBC, MOBC and physically challenged categories are entitled to a relaxation of 5% of marks for admission to HS Science course.
- (iii) Students, who wish to take up Economics, Mathematics and Statistics as combination, must have secured at least 45% marks on aggregate in HSLC or its equivalent Examinations. They will be allowed to take only CSA as 4th subject.
- (iv) Students declared to have passed HS First Year Exam. by the college / AHSEC, Assam, are eligible for admission to HS Second Year.

GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION:

ADMISSION NOTIFICATION OF H.S. 1st Yr. 2023-24

Following are the compulsory steps to apply for Admission into H.S. 1st Yr. Science/Arts/Commerce classes.

1. Firstly, AHSEC, online portal “DARPAN” Link – www.darpan.ahseconline.in or www.ahsec.assam.gov.in from Date of online Admission Form fill up will start from 09-06-2022.
2. Secondly, the candidates can be able to select five schools or colleges of their choice.
3. Thirdly, they shall be admitted to any of the selected institutions on the basis of their HSLC marks.

Guidelines for e-form fill up for Degree 1st Semester:

Students seeking admission in Degree 1st semester for the session 2023-24 are hereby advised to go through this Guidelines carefully before filling the e-form. Due to the implementation of new FYUGP by Gauhati University, subject combinations and course structure is changed from previous years. Students have to choose subjects very carefully as it will not be allowed to change subjects later on and wrong combination of subjects may lead to cancellation of his/her application form. For any query, relating to Degree 1st Semester form fill up, students can contact college authority at working hours.
